NATIONAL “NO CALL” LIST

If anyone is interested in getting on the National telemarketers NO CALL list here is the website for the Attorney General for the State of California. It will go in to effect in October but the list is getting to the FTC in July.

Californians can now pre-register at the Attorney General’s web site for the nationwide Do Not Call list that the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) is expected to launch this summer. California is joining in the national Do Not Call registry which is FREE to consumers.

If you sign up today, you can stop unwanted telemarketing calls beginning in October under the nationwide program.

They will deliver the pre-registered California telephone numbers to the FTC as soon as the federal Agency is ready to receive them – most likely in July 2003. Only California residential and mobile telephone numbers are eligible for this program. Business telephone numbers are excluded.

Beginning October 2003, telemarketers must stop calling consumers whose telephone number is on the national Do Not Call list.

While most telemarketer calls will be prohibited, there are certain exceptions. For example, charities, and companies that have an established relationship with a consumer will still be allowed to make calls.
